Proper Waste Disposal Guidelines: Separating Resources for Recycling

Place your trash at the designated collection point by 8:00 a.m. on the specified collection day. Note that collection times may vary due to changes in drop-off locations, road construction, or revised routes.

Any type of plastic packaging Confectionery bags; instant curry packaging; containers for cup noodles; lunch boxes; egg capsules; plastic bottle caps; shampoo and detergent bottles; tubes, etc.</p> <p>Items with  mark</p>  <p>Plastic products Plastic hangers, CDs, DVDs, plastic containers, polystyrene foam products, plastic buckets, etc.</p>  <p>The following items are not collected for recycling Containers that cannot be cleaned (to burnable waste); plastic umbrellas, razors, lighters (to non-burnable waste); mobile batteries (to collection boxes at retailers, etc.); injection needles used for home administration of medication (please contact your medical institution.)</p>	<p>Please place these items in a bag with the contents visible.</p>  <p>* Avoid double-bagging.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wipe with a cloth or rinse with water to remove dirt. Rinse the bottle lightly with water. Crush the bottle.
